BTSC Horsemanship Forum Saturday, Sept 7th

The BTSC Horsemanship Forum will be held on September 7th at 1pm in the Horse Park arena. This will give riders a chance to understand what Judges look for during a test and how to achieve better scores.

During the forum I will be talking about suppleness, gaits, riding corners, and the willingness of the horse to maintain a particular gait that is riding good round circles. I will try to answer any questions you may have. I have discovered that riding a TEST is much simpler than JUDGING!!

In the upcoming BTSC Horsemanship event currently scheduled for September 28th we are going to use Western Dressage Patterns Introductory Level Test 4 (no loping) and Basic Level Test 1 (loping).


BTSC Summer Beach Party Recap Saturday, August 10th


Bob Crowl, Keeve Krasner and Rich Vigue (who is taking the picture) successfully cut and cleared trails on the Sharp Top Loop


