Summer Party Saturday, August 10th



DIRECTIONS to 1122 Chestatee Point, Dawsonville, GA 30534

Traveling North on GA 400, go 1 mile past HWY 53 in Dawsonville to the first traffic light. Turn RIGHT onto HARMONY CHURCH ROAD and go 1 mile.

Turn RIGHT onto NIX BRIDGE ROAD and follow directions from → below.

OR

Traveling South on GA 400, go to HWY 136. Turn LEFT onto HWY 136 and go to 3-way STOP.

Bear RIGHT at stop, go 1 block and turn LEFT onto NIX BRIDGE ROAD. Follow directions from → below.

→ Go .9 (nine tenths) of a mile on Nix Bridge Road. Turn LEFT on CHESTATEE POINT and go to the STOP sign. Turn RIGHT at the stop sign (you will still be on Chestatee Point). Go to the very end of the road where two BLACKTOP driveways will be directly in front of you. Jo's is the BLACKTOP driveway on the right with the number 1122 painted on the blacktop. If Jo's driveway if full, park on the street.


