The raffle for the picture donated by Keeve Krasner will be a silent auction with sign up sheet, a 50/50 raffle will be run by Bob Crowl, and Lee Burger will run the raffle for the Booth Museum and the new Auto Museum tickets. People who plan on helping with set-up should be there at 5pm, doors open at 6pm, General meeting will start at 6:30pm with meal to follow immediately after the meeting.

New Business

- **Pavilion Roof Replacement** Bob Crowl reported that he spoke with Tom Fowler, the BT administrator. Tom Fowler indicated that BT will take care of the repairs; 'it is on the list to be done'.
- **Dragging Arena** Judie Uchitel clarified that Bob Crowl will drag the arena and get it done before the Omoksee event on March 20th.
- Insurance Judie Uchitel and Kathy Hardin reported that there are 2 quotes for next year; Allen Financial and Markel Insurance. The Allen Financial is less expensive, clearly covers up to 6 event locations (for member only events) and has been used by BTSC predominantly in the past. Joyce Delay made a motion to use Allen Financial. The motion was seconded and approved. The quote of \$533 is greater than the \$500 limit the EC can approve, it will then be presented to the membership at the general meeting for approval.
- Newsletter Articles Christine Cobb requested that all newsletter related items being sent to her have 'BTSC' in the subject line. Kathy Hardin thanked Christine for all the hard work getting the newsletter done.
- **Back Gate Procedures** Bob Crowl confirmed that back gate procedures will be the same as last year. Public safety will need the names of those needing access and the time of entry for the event.
- **BTSC Sign Damage** Bobby Delay looked at the damage to the sign at the arena. He will have the metalwork repaired and Kathy Hardin will organize having it repainted

PETE DILLINGHAM - MAY 14^{th,} 2022

Our renowned trainer, Pete Dillingham, has agreed to give a 2-day clinic at the BTSC Horse Park May14-15. He is also willing to arrange for private lessons for \$75 an hour on the following Monday, May 16th.

Bringing You and Your Horse Together is a potpourri of arena games and exercises (ground tying, respect my space, and circling game.) This 2-day clinic is aimed at developing manners (in and out of the saddle) and a loving communication between you and your horse. "Equal size, a rose between two thorns and the rope climb" are just a few of the entertaining challenges that develop more balanced riders, polite steeds, and most of all...a close relationship with your horse. This fast-paced, fun and informative event can be the "springboard" to Natural Horsemanship concepts/techniques and many wonderful memories. Our workshop is limited to 3-4 participants. There is 6-7 hours of instruction and we'll have a bring your own lunch break, and no one will have to be rocked to sleep at night.

This clinic is available to you at a cost of \$250 for the 2-day clinic. A \$125.00 deposit is required to hold your place for the clinic.
