So be prepared to make suggestions and discuss this and make a decision.

#### SECRETARY'S REPORT

#### Bent Tree Saddle Club - Executive Committee Consolidated Meeting Minutes 9/11/22

Meeting called to order by Judie Uchitel at 6:45pm

#### 1. Minutes

- Meeting mins reviewed and approved.

#### 2. Treasurers Report

- Joyce Delay reported that the current balance is \$2,916.55.

#### 3. Membership Report

- Bob Crowl report that there are 94 members. There are 1-2 riders interested in joining in October.

#### 4. Agenda Items

#### **Update on Upcoming Events**

- Prince Ride changed to Songbird Ride September 25th.
- Omoksee
- Christmas Party to be at Pendley Stables; Cost \$200 + fuel. Supplies will be needed and activities will include awards, Christmas music and BTSC videos. Judie Uchitel has volunteered to purchase a tree. Those who wish to assist with tree trimming will gather Friday, December 2nd then have dinner together.

#### 2023 EC Committee Updates

- Officer Nominations and future of club.
- Many current EC members will consider keeping their positions. Bobby Delay volunteered to fill the past president position as Judie Uchitel has volunteered to remain President. The group questioned if there were more BTSC members who have expressed interest in becoming involved. Planning will continue until all positions are filled and scheduling started.
- Some streamlining ideas were brought up for discussion and consideration by Ronda Erway to ease the burdens placed on the EC each year as the club participation decreases. After initial discussion, members decided to postpone further discussion until 2023 planning begins.
- Club renewals will only be done by mail/email with reminders by email. Phone follow-ups should be limited.
- Finances need to cover insurance not activities.
- Look into VENMO/PayPal for payments to club to eliminate payment delays.
- Decrease newsletter to bi-monthly or quarterly.
- Limit activities to 1/month.
- Social activities are paid for by attendees. Club funds will only be used if membership fees exceed that of paying insurance.
- Limit group rides or change to ride on your own luncheons.
- Attendance at all activities must be done by reservation not by drop in for planning purposes.
- All active members must volunteer to assist with some activity even if they don't ride. Use of property for activity could also be considered volunteering.
- Combine EC & GM meetings to make quarterly requirement or change by-laws. EC meeting would be 1st 30min then GM to follow.
- Consider reducing number of EC positions.
- Newsletter Articles September and October newsletter will be combined. Deadline for material to be sent to Christine Cobb is October 18th for a publication date of October 21st.

#### 5. New Business

- Non-member participation in Omoksee
- Insurance does not cover non-member participation in events. Although a liability form has been filed in the past, there is a question as to validity should there be an accident. By-laws state that members can bring up to 2 guests, but there is a question as to that being limited to social activities. This leads to the question of 'how to get others interested in the club'. One idea to be considered was a one-time 'activity membership' which would include liability form and a \$25 event fee instead of the std \$10 for full members.

Next meeting - October 12th or 13th, 2022 at 6:30 based on Cottage availability.
