St. Patrick's Day Bent Tree Ride Saturday, March 16*

Let's enjoy a little time on the Bent Tree horse trails while celebrating St. Patrick's Day early. Ronda Erway will lead a ride from the BTSC horse park through a Bent Tree loop. This loop will include a stop for lunch at her farm on Kelso Rd. where you can also visit the mini-cows. Plan to meet at the horse park and be ready to ride out at 11:30am. Remember to wear green, pack a lunch and expect a 1.5h ride time.

Bull Mountain Ride Wednesday, March 20th

OVERVIEW: This Ride will be held on Wednesday due to weekend high-volume biking-**BRING LUNCH.**


TRAIL DESCRIPTION: We will take the Bull Mountain Trail (223) to the Lance Creek Trail (223A). We will lunch in Booger Holler (A beautiful spot next to Lance Creek). Then we will decide if we are returning via the Whoop-De-Doo trail vs. the Cut off trail (only about a half a mile difference really) for the return portion.

This trail is considered moderate. Once we turn off the gravel approach service road, the trail has an elevation gain of about 1,486' over the next 4.0 miles. With an average of 5% grade. The Lance Creek descent is 575' descent over the next 2.4 miles. If some of you want to break off & ride in a smaller group, that's fine too, just let me know.

RIDE OUT TIME: 10:30AM! The Bull Mountain parking lot is a gravel one-lane road approx. 1.5 miles of slow going and curves. I estimate that to take about 20 minutes to get to the top. So, keep that in mind for arrival time. It is about an hour and 20-25 minute drive from Jasper (including the dirt road portion).
